Bruce attended the National AGM via zoom where members voted on a resolution to change the articles of association of The Third Age Trust, to change the governance structure of the u3a movement. The resolution was passed with 905 out of 1073 total votes in favour of the resolution. The Third Age Trust will now move towards having a smaller Board of Trustees and a new Council with regional representatives.

It was agreed that the annual subscription made to head office will stay at £4.

The Woodland 40th Anniversary tree planting, to which Ramsey members contributed, is progressing well. The trees are not yet strong enough to allow general visitors but we will receive regular updates.
